Subject: Declaration of intent not to accept gifts or gratuities  
In the performance of duties (No Gift Policy) Fiscal Year B.E. 2568 (2025)

Recognizing the importance of implementing the Government's policy in line with the National Reform Plan on the Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct, Office of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Education, has established an evaluation of integrity and transparency in the operations of its affiliated agencies (below the departmental level) for the fiscal year B.E. 2568 (2025). This aims to promote good governance, foster integrity in the performance of duties, build public trust, and meet the expectations of the public by cultivating an organizational culture that emphasizes transparency, rejects bribery and the acceptance of assets or other benefits, and prevents the misuse of authority or official position for personal or external gain.

Accordingly, to affirm its commitment to combating all forms of corruption, the Public Sector Development Group, Office of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Education, hereby declares that it will not accept gifts, gratuities, or any other benefits of monetary value in the performance of official duties. This policy aims to foster values and provide appropriate guidance for all personnel to adhere to, refraining from actions that could influence decision-making and lead to corruption and misconduct, both now and in the future. This includes performing duties with transparency, fairness, verifiability, and non-discrimination; prioritizing the public interest over personal benefit; and strictly adhering to ethical standards and the Civil Service Code of Ethics, thereby fostering a good organizational culture
